Visit VT Ranch and learn about the Chumash Indians. The Chumash were hunter-gatherers and were adept at fishing at the time of Spanish colonization. The Chumash lived with a bounty of resources. Much of their culture consisted of basketry, bead manufacturing and trading, cuisine of local abalone and clam, herbalism which consisted of using local herbs to produce teas and medical reliefs, and rock art.

## California Gold Rush Hands-On Field Trip







Learn about the history of the Gold Rush in your own backyard, not to mention the place where gold was first discovered in California. The first documented discovery of gold in California occurred in 1842 when Francisco Lopez, then a resident at Rancho San Francisco (Later known as Newhall Ranch), found the placer deposits in Placerita Canyon right here in Santa Clarita.
